## **RE: 2017 ANNUAL REPORT**

It's my pleasure and privilege that I write to express my heartfelt gratitude and appreciation on behalf of HACODEFU for your continued and unwavering support for our charitable efforts. We are very pleased to report that we continued our progress on a remarkable trajectory towards our endeavored mission to support the disadvantaged in our society through merit and need based academic scholarships. The year 2017 was another success story that saw us extend scholarships to college students who had been on our High School scholarships' program. Through our joint and concerted efforts and by God's grace, we managed to award 129 scholarships (121 to High School students and eight to University students). Together, we continued on a steady path of academic funding, capacity enhancement initiatives in the Hamisi region.

Figure 1: Sources of Revenue 2017




Figure 2: Distribution of Expenditure in 2017





Figure 3: HACODEFU Finances 2010-2017



## **Projects:**

## A: Education

We currently have 11 HACODEFU alumni who are enrolled in different public universities in Kenya. We aspire to continue keeping track of these youth beneficiaries of the HACODEFU scholarship fund for two important reasons; First, for the sake of accountability, and Secondly, for the desire to keep you in the loop on their advancement to tertiary education and career life after, whenever possible.
