
### **RE: 2020 ANNUAL REPORT**

- **III. Financial Tracker 2010-2020:** Revenues and expenses are tracked in Figure 3 below.






Figure 1: Sources of Revenue in 2020

Figure 2: Expenditure in 2020




Figure 3: Financial Tracker 2010- 2020

#### **Education**

## I. College Education

We continued to extend scholarships to 11 students in different colleges and universities in Kenya. We aspire to continue keeping track of these beneficiaries for the sake of accountability, and the desire to keep you in the loop on their advancement to post-secondary education and career life after, whenever possible.

## **II.** High School Education

We extended scholarships to a total of 138 high school students. Half of the scholarships were awarded to students attending Muhudu High School. The funding for Muhudu High School was able to keep 69 students in class, and, also, contribute to the construction of a classroom. We have big dreams for Muhudu High School, as we are planning to establish a center of excellence that will benefit both students and the local community.

# **Sustainable Fundraising Opportunities**

We continue with our mission to finding resources that will provide sustainable cash flow for our scholarship programs in perpetuity. We plan to have our inaugural dinner fundraiser in December of 2021 to the extent that people can travel and congregate following the current COVID-19 pandemic.
